Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to update you about the arrangements for remote learning next week from Monday, 9th to Thursday, 12th August.

The teachers today have been busy with planning and preparing for learning for next week. The work will include Literacy, Numeracy, Physical activity, RE and Inquiry. For those in Foundation to Grade 2 who require a device, this can be picked up today from 2-4pm. Grade 3 and 4 students can pick up their computers also at this time. Your child's teacher will let you know if there is other work for you to collect. Work packs and computers can be collected from the office from 2pm-4pm today (FRIDAY) and Monday morning from 8:30am. If these pick up times are not suitable, please contact your child's teacher to arrange for an alternative pick up time.

Teachers will once again have whole class Google Meets. A reminder that these are:

- 9am - 5/6 classes
- 9:20am - 3/4 classes
- 9:40am - Year 2
- 10am - Year 1
- 10:20am - Foundation

They are a chance for the teachers to gather the children together, check in on them and set them up for their learning for the day.

The times have been staggered to assist families who may have more than one child in the classes.

A registration form has been created for onsite learning for next week. Registration is for children who meet the following criteria:

Children where both parents and/or carers are authorised workers who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:

- Where there are two parents/carers, both must be authorised workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision
- For single parents/ carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.

Children experiencing vulnerability, including:

- children in out-of-home care
- children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and is assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
- children identified by a school as vulnerable, including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service.

Please note that registration for the following day closes at 5pm the day before. Parents/Carers are then contacted via email if attendance is accepted or declined. We will be following these guidelines more closely this time.
